

II International Workshop of Classical Homeopathy – Belo Horizonte, Brazil

The event took place on November 24, 25 and 26, 2017, in Belo Horizonte MG. The workshop brought together students from the E-learning Program of Classical Homeopathy and also students and professionals interested in gaining more knowledge about the articles of Prof. George Vithoukcas, as well as learn from the cases of Dr. Mahesh Mallapa and on the research in the ambit of Homeopathy with Dr. Seema Mahesh. Both doctors were connected via Skype.

With the objective of providing an enrichment in the students' scientific base, articles of Prof. Vithoukcas and collaborators were presented, to stimulate the thinking way directed to the scientific research and also to develop the questioning, researcher ability of the student.

On Friday night, we had the opening and presentations on the current situation of Homeopathy in the world, the challenges and perspectives and then presentation of the article by Prof. George Vithoukcas, et. al "*Homeopathic Treatment for prolonged postoperative coma: case report.*"

On Saturday morning we had the participation of Dr. Mahesh Mallapa directly from Bangalore, India. In the first presentation, Dr. Mahesh gave a demonstration of the live case taking, in which a participant was attended. In the next moment, we had the online transmission of Dr. Seema Mahesh, head of the IACH Research Department. Dr. Seema presented the current situation of research in Homeopathy, presented the cruciais points and encouraged the participants to adequately document their cases for future publication.

In the afternoon, we had presentations of articles by Prof. Vithoukcas, et. al: "*Homeopathy for the treatment of infertility: a series of cases*" and "*The effects of homeopathic treatment in women with premenstrual syndrome: a pilot study.*" On this day, we gave presentations about the E-learning program and also the programming of the courses at IACH in 2018. At the end of the day, we had a moment to make questions and discuss the questions of the participants and one of them shared with us his clinical experience about homeopathy, vaccines and other interesting points, among them how his vision changed after returning his studies to the methodology of Prof. Vithoukcas.

On Sunday, we began the day with the participation of Dr. Mahesh, with presentations of acute cases treated with Homeopathy. The interaction with the participants was very productive, all followed the clinical thinking way and enjoyed the moment to the maximum. Subsequently, na article of Prof. Vithoukcas were presented, "*The techniques for a successful repertorization*" and "*A resume of George Vithoukcas ideias on a New Model of Health and Disease*". We finished the event with the participation of Prof. George Vithoukcas online, answering all the questions of the participants.

We know how important it is to give the students opportunities for intellectual enrichment, to point out new perspectives and useful knowledge, so that growth will be an incessant search and as a consequence, they will become better professionals.
