



## **Classical Homeopathy in the Treatment of Serious Pathologies**

Webinar on the 24th and 25th of October 2020

The Webinar "Classical Homeopathy in the Treatment of Serious Pathologies" took place on the 24th and 25th of October 2020. It was organized by SPURO, in Portugal, with close collaboration with the International Academy of Classical Homeopathy (IACH).

It was the first event organized in Portugal, attended by 49 participants, mostly Portuguese and Brazilian, and by the speakers Dr. Seema Mahesh, Dr. Mahesh Mallappa and Prof. George Vithoulkas.

On the first day, after a short greeting made by the homeopath Alexandra Luís, from SPURO, Dr. Seema Mahesh began her presentation approaching the current situation of Investigation in Classical Homeopathy and highlighting the need of a bigger standardization and organization by the homeopaths when taking cases, mainly in the gathering of the clinical history of the patients (laboratory tests, clinical analysis, pictures, videos), so as to constitute accepted evidence by the scientific medical community.

The Webinar was then followed by Dr. Mahesh Mallappa, with the presentation of a difficult case of orchiepididymitis. Throughout his presentation, Dr. Mahesh highlighted the most relevant aspects of taking a case and its repertory, carried out the differentiated analyses of some homeopathic medicines, justified the prescription and presented the respective follow-up, with the cure of the patient.

After the lunch break, the Webinar continued with Dr. Seema and her presentation on the Continuum of a Unified Theory of Diseases. Dr. Seema alleged that, according with this theory, mentioned by Prof. Vithoulkas, the health condition of a certain person, in each moment, is the result of all the suffering and treatments until that moment, forming the diseases a continuum. Among various subjects, she also mentioned that all chronic degenerative diseases have a subacute inflammatory character, as a result of an unsolved acute inflammation and highlighted the most relevant aspects of this theory in the clinical practice context.

On the second day, the event began with the most awaited moment for all participants... the live question and answer session from Alonissos with Prof. Vithoulkas. After a warm greeting and with his simple, wise and engaging way of reaching everyone, Prof. Vithoulkas answered several questions made by the participants. Among other issues, he spoke about current matters such as the Covid-19 pandemic and the possibilities of homeopathy in its prevention and treatment. He also spoke about how he came up with his most recent article about the spin of electrons, as a way to prove the mechanism of action of homeopathic medicines. It was an exciting moment for all participants, in one hour that could have lasted for more hours.

After a quick break, Dr. Seema started her presentation by explaining the basic concepts of the Theory of Levels of Health, highlighting its importance in the clinical practice of all homeopaths. Lastly, she presented four cases of Diabetes Mellitus, which although they have the same medical diagnosis, they presented individualized homeopathic treatments, depending on the patients' health level.

The next presentation was from Dr. Mahesh with two more difficult acute cases of Covid-19 in which he looked, as it is usual in his educational presentations, to highlight the relevant aspects when taking cases, making the differentiated analyses of medicine, presenting the prescription, presenting the complications of a wrong medication and the respective follow-ups, with the cure of patients.

Lastly, Alexandra Luís made a short presentation of the online courses made by IACH, the courses which will take place in Alonissos, in 2021, of Prof. Vithoulkas' books in Portuguese, of the Seminar in Lisbon, scheduled for March 2021, and in the end she was available to answer questions.

Throughout the event, several videos of the Academy and the E-Learning Course of Classical Homeopathy were shown.

It was an intense and also very rewarding Webinar, given the presence of experienced and wise homeopaths with their hearts dedicated to Classical Homeopathy and to humanity.
